

Episodes

EP 1 - COMING OUT: After running into an old high school friend, a reform Jew turned conservative Christian, Jyl's faced with the challenge of coming out of the closet—as a stripper dater.

EP 2 - COMING FULL CIRCLE: What's all the fuss over dating a stripper? One word—sex. So, if you have access to the information, you want details. Jyl delivers—waterbeds, sex toys, motion sickness wristbands, and all.

EP 3 - COMING TO LA: "Stripper disease," Jyl's girlfriend's propensity to spend more than she earns, leads to their relationship's demise. Instead of wallowing in her sorrows, Jyl summons the courage to pack her bags and head to LA to start anew...or does she?

EP 4 - COMING TO TERMS: Jyl arrives in Los Angeles and quickly meets Stripper Girlfriend LA. Falling back into the stripper scene is bad enough, but when Jyl learns the differences between stripping on the coasts, she fears she may be in way over her head.

EP 5 - COMING TO A HEAD: Jyl confronts Stripper Girlfriend LA about her inner conflict with the stripper world. Okay, she doesn't exactly confront her. She writes her a poem. When Stripper Girlfriend LA's literary skills aren't quite up to snuff, things come to a head.

EP 6 - COMING TO AN END: Jyl ruminates on the differences between her life versus her girlfriend's. Who's she to pass judgment? Still, Jyl can't ignore the gnawing in her stomach. Something has to change. Will Jyl lose her girlfriend or herself in the process?
